CONSTRUCTION

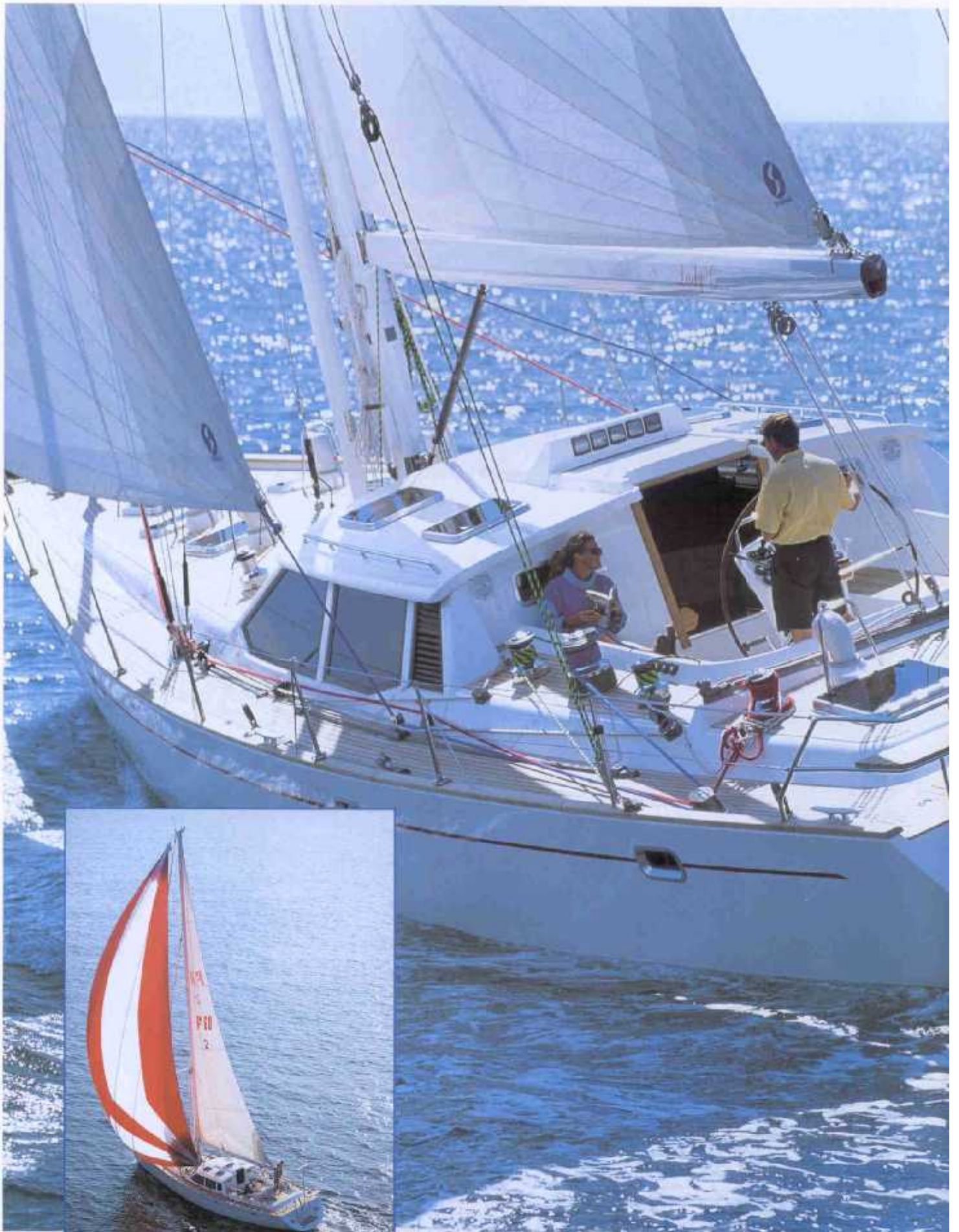

From its beginnings, building wooden yachts capable of surviving the rugged Scandinavian sea conditions to today's modern yacht construction in its impressive, purpose-built factory, Najad have always valued skilled craftsmanship and close attention to detail.

The Farr Pilot House yachts take shape in Najad's factory with a specially selected team of eight expert craftsmen working on them throughout the build, supported and assisted by Najad's in-house design team, workshops and skilled technicians. 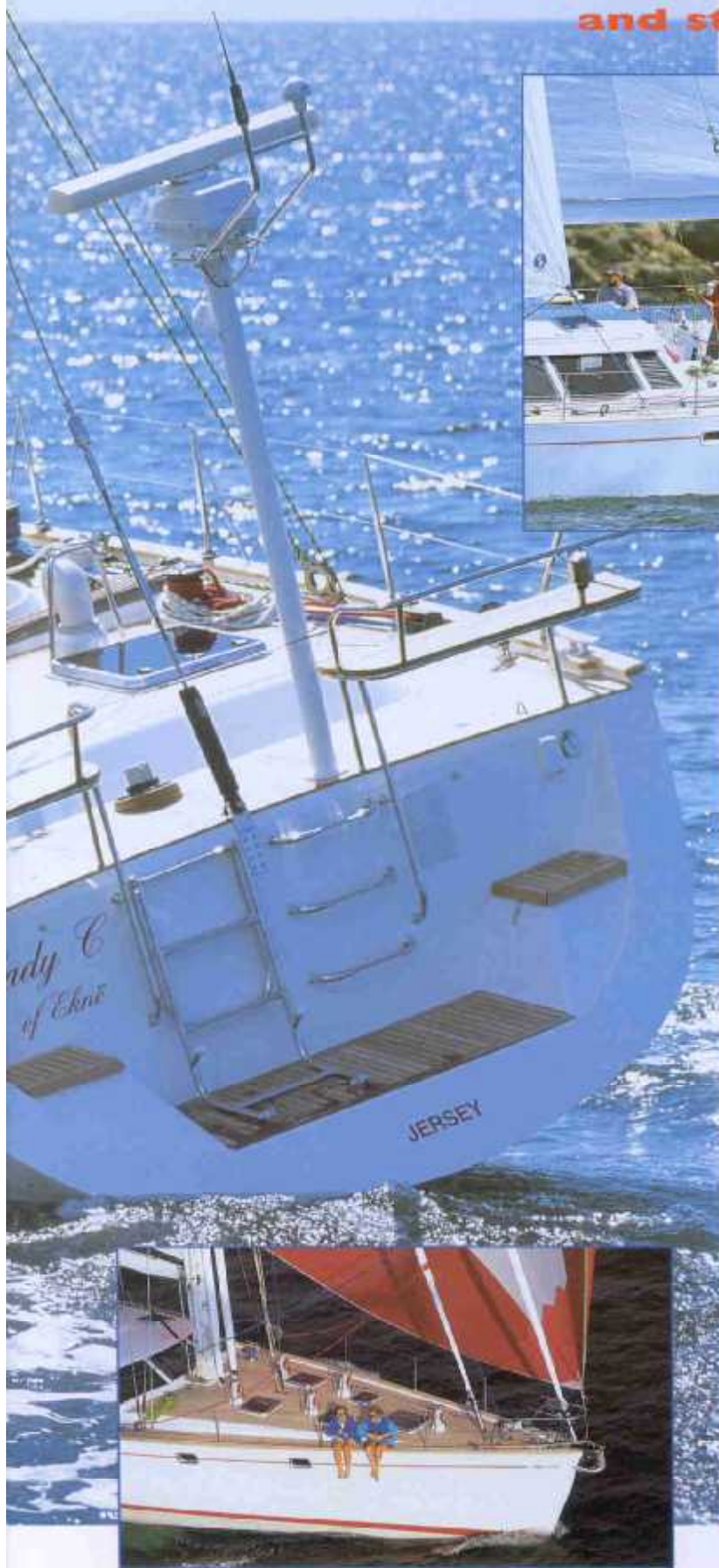
The Farr 60 has more than lived up to her design criteria which were for a yacht that could be easily sailed short handed, would produce impressive passage times in a variety of weather conditions and give exhilarating performance when required.

Owners comment that the Farr 60 is responsive, stiff and offers a minimum angle of heel when going to windward. The unique hull shape provides a sparkling performance and yet still offers optimum handling capabilities. In fact, her ease of handling enables even unseasoned sailors to feel confident at the helm.

Sail handling is simple with In-mast Mainsail furling and furling Genoa and Staysail, all hydraulically controlled from the cockpit, where efficient power winches take the strain. Spinnakers and cruising chutes are effortlessly hoisted from the forehatch, then easily handed and stowed in the forward workshop.

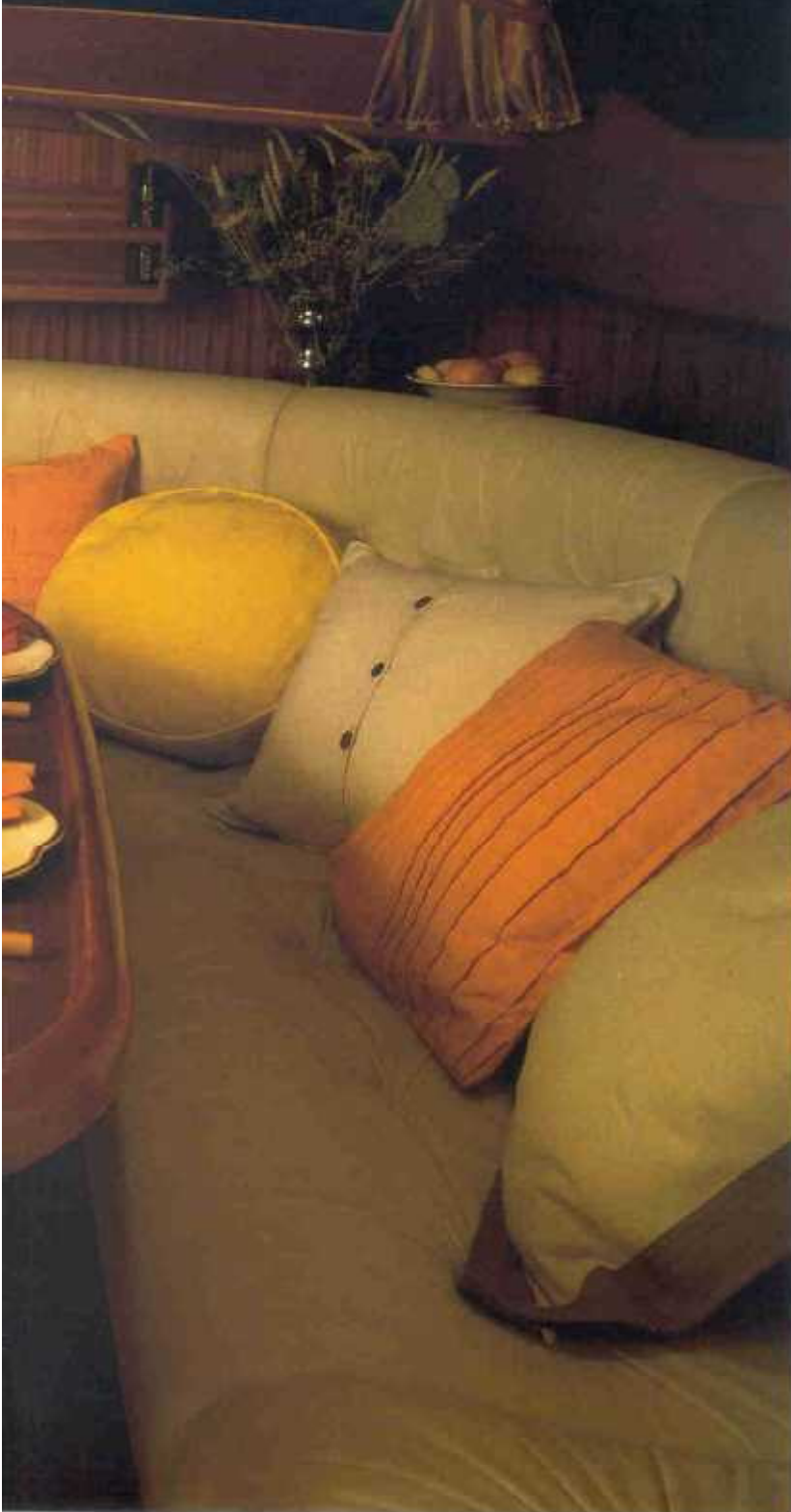
Farr Pilot House yachts not only produce excellent sailing they are truly yachts for ocean living -

For our interiors, high quality and outstanding finish will always be priorities, combined with the need for functionality and durability.

The outstanding features of this range are the Pilot Houses that offer 360-degree vision and light, airy saloons. Navigation stations are always easy to access from the cockpit and offer excellent visibility, day and night. The option of effective, joystick autopilot control enable watches to be taken safely from the Pilot Houses, allowing helmsmen to shelter from adverse weather conditions or simply stay in touch with the party below.

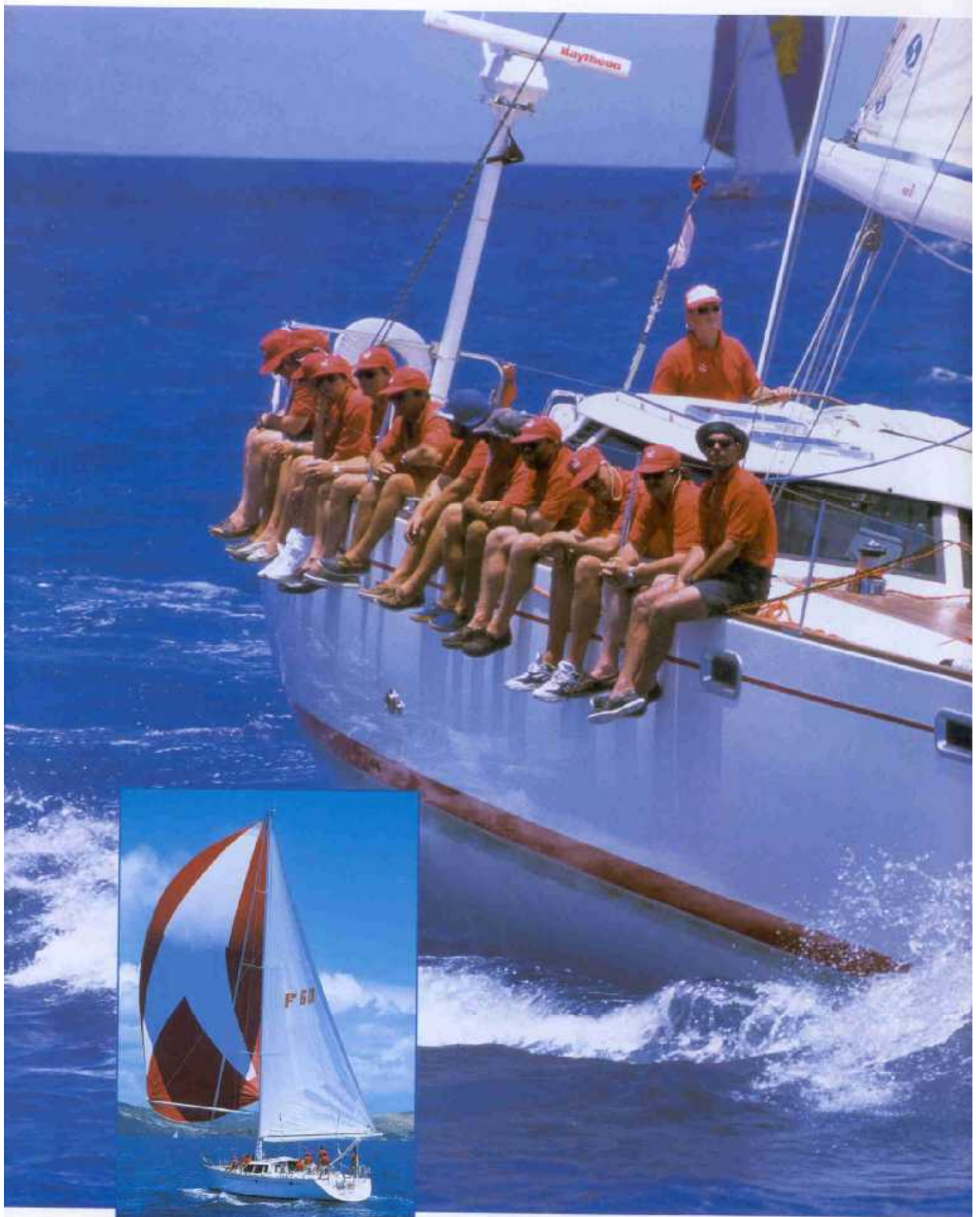
Both the Farr 50 and Farr 60 provide excellent owner accommodation, giving the comfort and room essential for long distance cruising.

On the Farr 60 the sumptuous aft cabin has a king-size bed, writing bureau and sofa. Its impressive saloon table can accommodate a dinner party for eight and the large, well equipped galley is easily able to cope with such demands. It offers 3 separate fridge-freezers, full size cooker, powerful microwave, ample work surfaces, a double sink and enough storage space to put a town kitchen to shame.

The refinements on these yachts do not stop at accommodation. In all layout options, both the engine and machinery room are easily accessed and carefully soundproofed. Forward workshops are available providing stable workbenches for repairs, generous areas for sail handling and pipecot accommodation for crewed yachts.

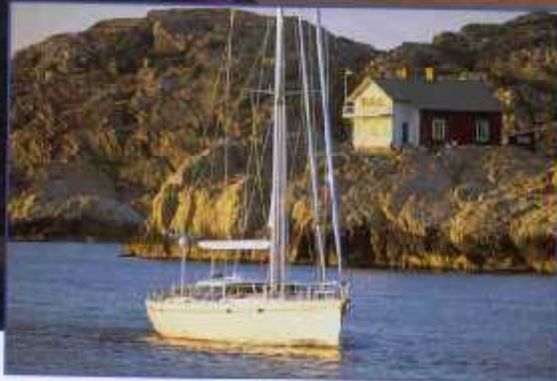
